DEVELOPMENT OF AI SOFTWARE AGENTS

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Overview & Background

The United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan (USEFP) was established in 1950 by the governments of Pakistan and the United States. USEFP is a binational commission composed of an equal number of Pakistanis and Americans, with the Chair alternating between a Pakistani and an American. USEFP is one of 51 'Fulbright Commissions' located throughout the world. Since 1951 when the first group of Pakistani grantees travelled to America and in 1952 when the first American grantees visited Pakistan, the USEFP has fostered mutual understanding between the people of Pakistan and the United States through educational and cultural exchange. Nearly 4,000 Pakistanis and more than 800 Americans have participated in USEFP administered exchange programs.

The Foundation receives support and counsel from both the Pakistan and U.S. Governments, but it is not an agency of either. The Foundation supervises a variety of programs that send Pakistani students and scholars to American campuses while bringing American scholars to universities in Pakistan. The goal of all USEFP programs is to help Pakistanis learn more about the U.S. and to help Americans learn more about Pakistan and its people.

2 Purpose of this Document

The purpose of this document is to specify the approach that USEFP will use to select the **Firms** interested in developing AI Software Agents/Modules for the United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan.

This document also describes the requirements that the Firms must fulfill in order to be selected.



The United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan (USEFP) has pioneered a sophisticated scholarship management system, handling over 40,000 applications annually, alongside efficient grantee and alumni management for over 8,000 individuals. Development of three AI agents is required to enhance the capabilities of our systems:

1. AI Reporting – ChatGPT-style generative AI agent:

This AI-based reporting engine, designed in a chatbot format reminiscent of ChatGPT, will harness the power of natural language processing to interact with our data. Users can query it in plain English, and it will provide insightful responses. Additionally, it will offer the functionality to generate reports based on unspecified criteria, exporting them in Excel and PDF formats.

2. AI Application Check (Information Consistency) – Cross-referencing application information with supporting documents:

This AI agent, equipped with image processing and optical character recognition (OCR) capabilities, will analyse documents uploaded by students, such as CVs, transcripts, and degrees. It will compare the information extracted from these documents against the details provided in the applications. Currently, this verification process is manual and time-consuming, taking 2-3 months due to the volume of applications. Implementing this AI agent will significantly reduce processing time from months to mere minutes.

3. AI Plagiarism Check – Detection of AI-generated personal statements and study objectives:

This AI agent will scrutinize essays within applications to assess the probability of their generation by AI writing software like ChatGPT, Bard, or Gemini.
